

Prospect Court is a supported living care service providing a mixture of one and two bedroomed shared flats based in Sutton, Surrey. We provide care and support for up to 36 adults between the ages of 21-64 who have epilepsy, learning and physical disabilities or other complex needs.

Our person lead approach is driven through bespoke support plans and outcomes for people. Where required, our ethos of delivering support through the fundamental principles of Positive Behaviour Support is also in place. The aim of our PBS framework is not merely to reduce levels of challenging behaviour for people, but to improve quality of life.

Our highly experienced staff provide 24-hour care along with waking night specialist support. The trained team offer the maximum standards of care and support to tenants, whilst enabling people to live as independently as possible within their own homes.

We recognise that our tenants needs may be medical/therapeutic, emotional, spiritual, physical or social and the appropriate support will be provided to all. Each tenant will be fully involved in the development of their individual person-centred plan, and all tenants will be supported to reach their full potential at their own pace.

A key worker will meet with each tenant each month on a one-to-one basis to discuss their goals and aspirations. These sessions will be for any concerns or issues they may have and to provide support and communication. In these sessions, they can plan and carry out leisure, employment, and college activities if this will be pro-active towards their targets.

We prioritise socialisation and fun activities to keep our tenants busy and motivated. We are pleased to hold BBQs, parties and birthday celebrations in our spacious back garden. We encourage and support individuals to go for walks locally and to nearby towns to keep active.

We strive to preserve and maintain dignity, individuality and privacy of all tenants, and in doing so our trained team are aware of tenants own unique needs.
