Whalley Road in Accrington, Lancashire, is a specialist residential home providing mental health care, support and rehabilitation to adult males with a mental illness or learning disability. Some of our residents stay with us longer-term, others just for a short time before moving on.

We have nine en-suite bedrooms across three floors, and a large garden. Our residents and their families are involved in developing their own care plans and in choosing the way they live their lives.

We work closely with each resident to help build their skillset and help them to be more independent in everyday life. At Whalley Road, we are committed to supporting our residents to be independent, confident, and resilient.

We understand that all residents that we support have different needs. As such, our approach promotes both physical and mental wellbeing goals to optimise a health lifestyle. Working alongside key workers, families, and medical professionals, we ensure that the support that we provide is person-centered.

Every resident has a comprehensive support plan which covers every aspect of their care and support, taking in to account any concerns and issues that may arise and ensuring all needs and requirements are met enabling them to live the very best life possible.

We support adult males aged 18 years and older who have been diagnosed with a mental health condition or learning disability.

Our primary aim is to support residents to a point where they are confident enough to be able to live independently. Personal growth and development is an essential part of our pathways ethos. By encouraging residents to learn new skills, take up hobbies and try out different activities, they feel empowered to be the best that they can be. Residents can gain a more positive outlook about what they can achieve and about their future, as well as be comfortable with themselves and become more integrated into local communities.

Our team are experienced in supporting adult males with mental health conditions and learning disabilities. We want every resident we look after to feel as if they are being supported by a family member and to feel completely at home and at ease in our service.
